

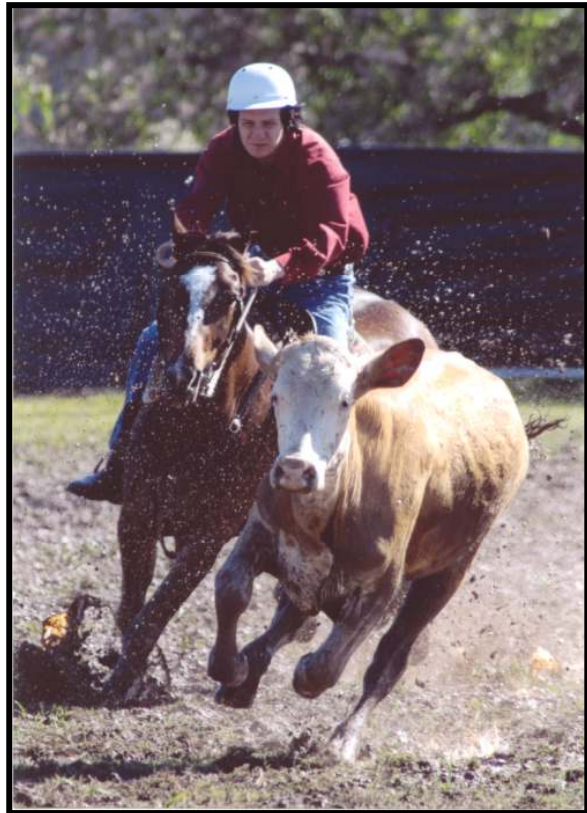
ARAKOOLA NIKKI

This gentle tempered brown mare has been there done it all even at her young age showing the versatility and temperament the Australian Stock Horse is renowned for. Nikki is out of **Arakoola Kiri (Tokens Trinkette/Arakoola Ember)** and thorough her grandsire Arakoola Ember is the 4th generation of these horses to be bred at Arakoola, going back to **Amber C** an **Apple Jack** mare a mare owned by Brian Hodges in the beginning. Nikki was started and lightly campaigned by Erin Hodges as a 4 yo, she attended pony club with Ian Hodges and then went on to compete in pony club, dressage and ASH showing with Emily Peterson. As a 6yo Nikki was campaigned by Erin Hodges winning numerous Champion and Reserve titles at local Agricultural Shows in both ASH hack and working classes and ASHLA with Cody Peterson. At the ASH Nationals in 2007 Erin & Nikki were Reserve Champion working mare. Following Nationals Nikki returned home to play polox with Ian Hodges gaining many favorable comments in her first few games. Her half brothers **Arakoola Medallion** (Supreme Champion Hack at ASH Nationals in 2006) and **Arakoola Andy** (1st ASHLA Sydney Royal 2006 & 2007) have excelled ASH events and many other disciplines.

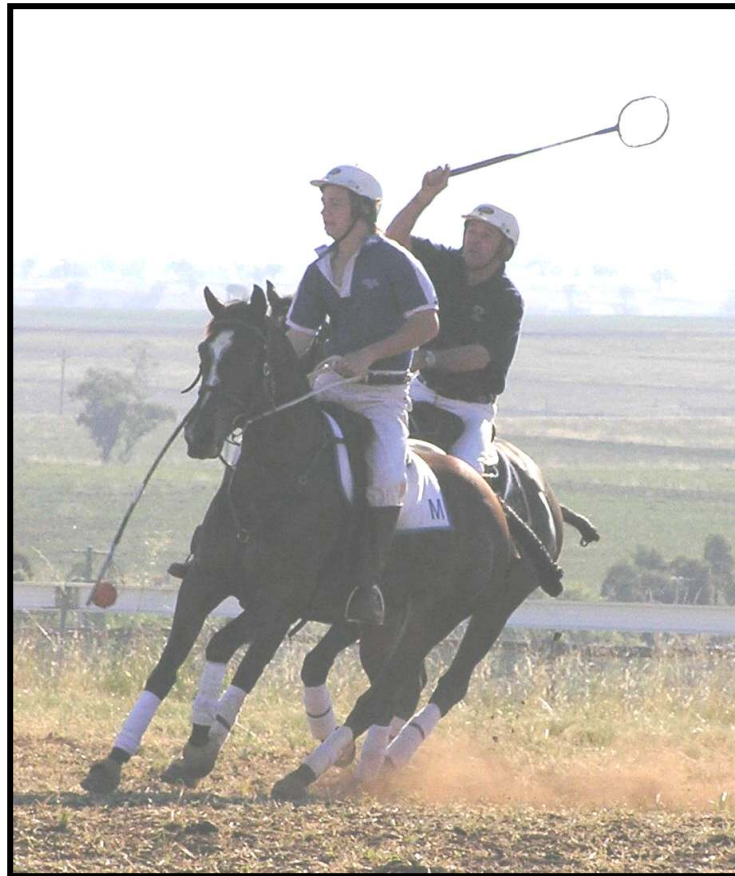
